



Call My Bluff

R U L E S

1. **DATE & VENUE** - The County Final will be held on 16th September, starting at 7:30pm at the Waie Inn.
2. **REPRESENTATION** - Groups may enter one Intermediate team (22 & under) and one Senior team (28 & under).
3. **ELIGIBILITY** – The Intermediate team shall consist of three members who must be 22 years of age or under on 1st September 2021. The Senior team shall consist of three members who must be 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2021. Competitors will be required to be signed up YFC members for the year 2021-2022.
4. **HEALTH & SAFETY & SAFEGUARDING** - All competitions carried out at every level must comply with Health and Safety Legislation and meet the relevant safety standards.

All competitions must comply with NFYFC Covid-19 guidelines.

A completed DFYFC Parental Consent form is required for every member under the age of 18 wishing to compete and must be available on the day of competition, including the specific online parental consent form if the competition is being held virtually.

5. **PROCEDURE** - Each team will be sent 3 (three) words with the correct dictionary explanation, **two weeks before the Competition**. The three team members each give their definition, one true and two bluff's to try and fool the other team, explanations should last no longer than 1 minute. There is no rule that each member must give a correct definition.

One of the opposing team members (1 turn each) has to guess which is the correct explanation; members are allowed to confer, for a maximum of 4 minutes, however the chosen member has to make the final decision (within the 4 minutes).
2 points will be awarded for the correct answer.

There will be three rounds, therefore, allowing each team member the opportunity to outwit the opposition.

Teams will be judged on the creativity put into trying to “Bluff” the opposition. 10 points per word, thirty points per round, making a total of 90. Teams will also be judged on how they present themselves including their discussion of their opposing team’s definition of the word and how they work as a team on the day.

Time deductions are 1 mark for each half-minute (or part thereof) over the allotted time by any member of the team.

6. **SCALE OF MARKS -**

7. **Late Withdrawal of Entries**

No deposits will be required from Group teams prior to the County final.

However, withdrawals or cancelations made less than 48 hrs before the day of the final will result in an administration charge of £25.

All administration charges are invoiced to Groups for these competitions

8. **AWARDS –**

The winning Senior Team will receive the Griffiths & Partner Cup, the winning Intermediate Team will receive the John Berry Cup. The Best Junior Male and Female speaker and the Best Senior Male and Female speaker shall each receive a Call my Bluff Shield.

The top 3 teams in Intermediate and Senior categories will receive 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize cards.
