

Mare and Foal Sanctuary: Estates Manager

The Mare and Foal Sanctuary is the largest equine welfare charity in the South West peninsula dedicated to the rescue, rehabilitation and rehoming of horse and ponies who have suffered neglect, abuse and trauma.

As Estates Manager, you will ensure that our estates, buildings and landholdings provide an appropriate and safe environment for the charity to deliver its corporate objectives and day to day activities. You will have the knowledge and skills to instruct and oversee all aspects of property, land management, general building and maintenance work and the ability to do 'hands on' practical work when required.

You will be responsible for the safe, efficient and effective provision of planned and reactive maintenance and facility support activities delivered by the Estates team. This includes the management of our landholdings, some of which is done in-house and some by contractors. You will also oversee day-to-day aspects of contractor compliance, building compliance and budget management, including purchasing.

You will have supervisory experience and you will ideally hold a relevant industry qualification as well as a strong understanding of site safety and culture, possibly underpinned by a certificated course.

The post is based at Coombe Park Equestrian and Education Centre, Littlehempston, near Totnes (with travel to other sites as required), working 37.5 hours per week. Flexible work patterns will be considered.

Salary: £29,913 - £32,118 per annum plus contributory pension, healthcare cash back scheme and company van or mileage allowance. This role is subject to an enhanced DBS check.
