

Mixed Hockey Rules



Sunday 17th July 2022 - 9.30am Registration, Play Starts 9.45am

Isca College, Exeter, EX2 6AP

ELIGIBILITY – Clubs may enter one team subject to the number of entries in the County Final. The tournament will be run in two leagues. Clubs may declare a squad of 9 people, from which 7 will be chosen to form a team for each game, all of whom must have attained the age of 16 years of age on the day of the competition, and 28 years of age or under on 1st September 2022.

PROCEDURE –

● **Registration of teams is at 9:30am with Play starting at 9.45am prompt.**

● The Rules of the Game of Hockey will apply.

● **All Players will be required to show their Current, Valid (signed and photo attached) Membership Cards. Failure to produce a valid card will mean that that person will not be allowed to play.**

● Completed Parental Consent forms, for all members under the age of 18, must be available on the day of competition.

● The goalkeeper must wear the full goalkeeper kit, including facemask and shin pads, as specified by HA Rules.

● All players are strongly encouraged to wear shin protection.

● Players must be 16 years of age and above and competent in the Game of Hockey.

● Clubs may declare a squad of 9 people from which 7 will be chosen to form a team for each game.

● A minimum of 3 girls must be in play on the pitch at any time.

● Games will be 8 minutes one way and may be reduced depending on number of teams entered.

● If a team arrives late 1 goal will be awarded to the opposition for every minute, if 5 minutes late the match will be forfeited.

● Teams entered will be divided into 2 leagues, the winner from league 1 will play the runner up in league 2 and the winner in league 2 will play the runner up in league 1 in the semi-finals. Then the final will be the winners from each play off for 1st and 2nd with the runners up playing for 3rd & 4th.

In the case of a draw in the finals, additional time will be played on a 'golden goal' basis, failing this penalty flicks will be played.

● The competition will be run on a league basis, points as follows -

Win	-	3 points	No Score draw	1 point
Score draw	-	2 points	Lose	0 point

In the event of the points being tied, the order will be decided using the greatest positive goal difference.

● **Late Withdrawal of Entries**

No deposits will be required from Club teams prior to the County final.

However, withdrawals or cancelations made less than 48 hrs before the day of the final will result in an administration charge of £25. All administration charges are invoiced to your Club for this competition
