

Dairy/Agricultural Hand, Goat Dairy

We are recruiting a dairy hand for our new dairy with the opportunity to grow and develop your skills as our business grows.



We are looking for minimum of 30 hours a week, across 5 mornings including one at the weekend. Pay levels are competitive and based on experience.

The milking herd comprises 120 nannies who will start kidding in April, followed by one milking per day. The milk will be used to supply our cheese making activities. We have up to an additional 120 younger goats depending on the time of the year. Whilst the role is primarily goat focussed (husbandry, grazing management and milking) it also includes general farm work. The chosen candidate will work both independently and alongside the owners depending on the activity and experience.

This vacancy would suit either an experienced stockperson who can help build and maintain a comprehensive approach to sustainable husbandry, or someone with less experience who is flexible in approach and willing to learn and take on duties as they grow. Above all, they would need to demonstrate reliability and resilience as well as respect for animals and a commitment to sustainable farming practices.
