Accommodation

- Separate boys and girls showers and toilets are located close by.
- Leaders have separate facilities.
- You can request who you share a tent with when you book.



Food

- All meals are freshly cooked and include:
 - Hot and cold meals with veggie options
 - Homemade soup everyday
 - Self-service salad bar
 - Fresh fruit
- Cooked breakfast is available every morning or continental options too.
- Hot meal at lunch time or sandwiches.
- All dietary requirements can be catered for.



Who's going?

- Junior camp is open to all junior YFC members from Cornwall, Devon, Somerset, Dorset, Wiltshire and Gloucestershire.
- We have reserved spaces for 125 junior members along with 15 leaders.
- The weekend organiser is Pip Cusack (Somerset YFC) and there will be at least one leader from every County coming too!
- County leaders will be accompanying members from the moment they get on the coach until they get home again.
