County Federation representation – ‘Direct Entry’ competition finals

1. The general representation rule for ‘direct entry’ competitions states:
 - 1.1. **County Federations will be represented by ONE team per 600 members or part thereof.**
2. The number of members used to do this calculation will be the number of members declared in the annual membership return dated 31 August 2025
 - Therefore: 1 – 600 members = 1 team
 - 601 – 1200 members = 2 teams
 - 1201 – 1800 members = 3 teams
 - And so on....
3. **Please be sure to read the Representation paragraph of the competition rules – variations do apply in some cases.**

County Federation representation – ‘Double Direct Entry’ competition finals

4. The general representation rule for ‘double direct entry’ competitions states:
 - 4.1. **County Federations will be represented by TWO teams per 600 members or part thereof.**
5. The number of members used to do this calculation will be the number of members declared in the annual membership return dated 31 August 2025
 - Therefore: 1 – 600 members = 2 team
 - 601 – 1200 members = 4 teams
 - 1201 – 1800 members = 6 teams
 - And so on....

YFC Areas and Wales representation – ‘Area Eliminator’ competition finals

7. The general representation rule for YFC Area/Wales eliminator competitions states:
 - 7.1. **Areas will be represented by ONE team per 3,000 or part thereof.**
8. The number of members used to do this calculation will be the aggregate number of members declared for county federations that make up a YFC Area or Wales FYFC in the annual membership return dated 31 August 2024.
9. The county federations that make up each Area and Wales are as listed overleaf.
 - Therefore: 1 – 3,000 members 1 team
 - 3,001 – 6,000 members 2 teams
 - 6,001 – 9,000 members 3 teams
 - And so on....

YFC Areas and Wales representation – ‘Double Area Eliminator’ competition finals

10. The general representation rule for YFC Area/Wales eliminator competitions states:
 - 10.1. **Areas will be represented by TWO teams per 3,000 or part thereof.**
11. The number of members used to do this calculation will be the aggregate number of members declared for county federations that make up a YFC Area or Wales FYFC in the annual membership return dated 31 August 2024
12. The county federations that make up each Area and Wales are as listed overleaf.
 - Therefore: 1 – 3,000 members 2 team
 - 3,001 – 6,000 members 4 teams
 - 6,001 – 9,000 members 6 teams
 - And so on....
